 - Motion made to approve last meetings minutes. Seconded. All in favor and approved.

Principals Update

- Mr. Guerin shared that it's been a great start to the year
- There were no questions from attendees
- Parent teacher conferences will be virtual this year

Treasurer Report:

- Juliana Kuszewski shared the treasurer report
- 6 teacher reimbursements so far this year totaling \$600
- Had to pay out some rollover requests from last year: black lights, 6 grade field day, 3rd grade Barnes and Noble books
- We will be keeping roughly the same budget as last year with the addition of:
 - Shirts for pre-k
 - Community fund (for our community members experiencing hardship, tragedy/loss, etc)

Fundraising & Volunteer Opportunities:

- Anticipating another low key year due to Covid restrictions
- Square One Art- will happen in the fall this year
 - Ms. Vinton has everything she needs and has started projects with students already

Jen and Jacki are running this fundraiser

Scholastic Book Fair

- One in the fall, one in spring
- We could consider an outdoor fair this year
- Tents are coming end of September which may make an outdoor fair more feasible
- Virtual fair last year was not super successful
- Michele currently runs the book fairs, she would like to train someone to take over. Christina LaFortune is interested in helping and learning
- o We will need more volunteers when in person fairs resume
- We currently have \$500 scholastic dollars, which does not cover what we typically distribute to the school community
- Board discussed setting aside \$3,000 from the general budget to cover our usual distributions (New Teachers, Reading Room, Meunier, Orientation Books, Library, Pelley's Picks, Teacher Wish List Raffles)
 - Motion made to approve \$3,000 from the general budge to cover the scholastic dollar shortage. Seconded. All in favor and approved.
